Clinic Fees, Format, Rules, Etc.

Riders Fees: \$450 for riders. Includes corral, feed, mucking and facility usage. (RdP client fee \$400) Clinic limited to 8 riders ONLY.

Auditors Fees: \$25 per day or \$60 for a 3-day auditor's pass (RdP client fee \$20 per day, \$50 for a 3-day pass) CASH PAYMENT ONLY for auditors

Deposit: \$200 non-refundable deposit is required to reserve a rider slot

Refunds: *There are no refunds*

Format: Daily 10:00-5:00 1 hour lunch

Day 1: Group introduction, followed by Individual sessions with each rider; all riders are expected to audit and learn from fellow rider's sessions

Day 2: Morning: individual sessions with riders 1-4; lunch break; Afternoon: Group session with all riders

Day 3: Morning: individual sessions with riders 5-8; lunch break; Afternoon: Group session with all riders

General Rules & Regulations:

- One horse ONLY per rider; horses deemed unsound by the clinician MAY NOT participate.
- NO DOGS ALLOWED (leashed or otherwise);
- Auditors may not bring horses;
- All riders must complete Liability Release forms (to be provided upon receipt of non-refundable deposit);
- All riders and auditors must adhere to Rancho Dos Palmas Rules & Regulations (review at www.ranchodospalmas.com)
- There are no discounts for early departure, missed or partial sessions, etc.
- RdP reserves the right to refuse service to anyone.
